•	General question posed: How might these added committees		
	benefit the PTSO community reach and expand perspectives?		
	What "problem" are we solving by adding each as a		
	committee?		
	Open Discussion:		
•	Consideration may be required for length of meetings to make		
	sure that we have enough time to hear updates from each		
	committee as we expand.		
•	Having a seat at the table may be beneficial for visibility for the		
	organizations Want to make sure that the broader community		
	is aware of these two groups.		
•	The role of each of these committees would need to be		
	distinguished and defined.		
•	ELL families may be missed in PTSO communications due to		
	language and cultural barriers and has been identified as		
	underrepresented and a potentially marginalized community.		
	While NPS has adopted better translation software for		
	communications, this is just one step. Having an ELL committee representative, we may learn / better understand some of the		
	ways that different communities receive and pay attention to		
	information.		
•	FORJ was created city-wide through NPS, creates a learning		
	community for families as well. There is representation on		
	some elementary and middle school PTSO committees and		
	serve to educate and communicate messaging, not necessarily		
	represent an underserved population. Have expressed interest		
	in engaging more with PTSO, which may be initially best served		
	by inviting FORJ to attend a PTSO meeting and provide		
	information.		
•	All in favor of an ELL Committee, with prospective connections		
	to get started. PTSO to reach out to the ELL teachers to identify		
	potential parent reps.		
•	Some question about whether a FORJ Committee is a good fit		
	to join the board, but invite them to come to a board meeting		
	to share more about their programming
